Peter Elfelt was the royal Danish court photographer, and his film recordings contain most of the Danish royal family's participation in events, as well as many of the important artists and scientists of the period. This collection is therefore important as a historical source, as well as an immediate attention getter as to how Copenhagen and people looked 100 years ago.
